These are just several of the many recent occurrences where Banner Bears was able to provide comfort for children in traumatic conditions. Because of Messengers like you, we have been able to reach out to many of these children to provide a teddy bear bundle or a teen bundle to give them words of comfort and to give the children, and possibly their families, the message and hope of Jesus.

Last year we were busy with not only delivering bundles, but also adding our own coloring book for the children and we also added a teen bundle to minister to teenagers. However, this year we have not had many changes in our operations, so this has enabled us more time to focus entirely on striving to reach the multitudes of children who are hurting. The task seems daunting at times because the need is endless.

This past spring was the first our ministry has reached out to a children's hospital. We had the opportunity to deliver 100 teddy bear bundles to the Maynard Children's Hospital in Greenville NC. Also, to our list of deliveries, we have added more domestic abuse centers and rescue missions. Banner Bears delivered for the first time to the Raleigh area this year, so God has now opened doors for us north, south, east and west from our Rocky Mount/Red Oak location.

On Saturday, August 3, we will have our 2<sup>nd</sup> annual fundraising painting class with the local artist, Noel Butler. The Red Oak Rotary graciously sponsors this for us every year.
